Important information regarding band camp:

- 1. BE ON TIME EACH DAY! (If you show up at 8:30 a.m., you're already late.)
- 2. Be prepared to work with a functional instrument, a pencil, dot book, a water bottle, sun screen, hat/cap, comfortable sneakers (no flip flops or bare feet).
- 3. You will NOT need a watch. Time will pass without one.
- 4. Cell phones will not be permitted during camp hours. Leave them in your cubby or at home.
- 5. Students should have a good breakfast each day before coming to band.
- 6. Students are not allowed off campus for any reason during camp hours.
- 7. The Norton Music Boosters will feed students a healthy lunch as well as an afternoon snack.
- 8. Proper attire is required during camp. Halter tops, bathing suits, and inappropriate messages on clothing are not permitted. Males must wear shirts at all times.
- 9. Personal medications must be given to the medical person on duty before camp.
- 10. No food or drink, other than water, is permitted in the band room.
- 11. Thursday lock-in is an important part of camp. All students must attend.
- 12. Parents are encouraged to stop by throughout the week to observe.
- 13. Parents are encouraged to attend parent band camp on Saturday, August 4th at noon.
- 14. All students will be admitted to Loyal Oak Lake Park for free at the Family Picnic.
- 15. Parents and guests will be charged a discounted ticket price when entering Loyal Oak Lake Park.
