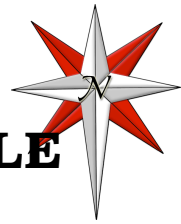

Practices:

Wind Ensemble has mandatory rehearsals Thursday evenings for two hours. Discussion in class will determine the most convenient block of time b/w 5-9:30pm.

Concert Band will have occasional sectionals after school based on availability and need. Students will be informed at least a week in advance.

ALL STUDENTS are expected to contribute 15-30 minutes of individual development each day. "Homework" is assigned everyday in class. Students may be asked to record excerpts as assessments. Daily preparation is necessary for achievement.

Private Lessons:

I am excited to say that more and more students are taken advantage of the private lesson program supplied by the music boosters. Private lessons offer one on one instruction by a professional instructor on each instrument. It is invaluable for specific techniques, fundamental development, and student confidence! It is highly recommended for all students! The boosters cover \$7 of each lesson. Lessons spanning from \$12-\$18.
